

A prominent and inescapable feature of Pope Benedict XVI's pontificate is the importance which has been given to the sacred liturgy, in its actual celebration, as well as in the popes' Magisterium and theological writings. Not only have we witnessed the reappearance of many elements used in older, but recently-abandoned papal liturgies, but also what amounts to be the virtual liberation of the Old Latin Mass. This has come as a great surprise to many people in the Church, some of whom almost regard it, and the popes' liturgical theology, as a betrayal of recent liturgical reforms.
